

Resolution No. 1

Resolution adapted at the Central Executive Committee Meeting of the Ministerial Staff Association, Survey of India held on 25th & 26th September 2018 at the Conference Hall of Jabalpur, MPGDC.


This Central Executive Committee Meeting of M.S.A., Survey of India notes with a reasonable degree of concern that the much-spoken-of Cadre Restructuring is yet to get finalised and implemented even after a lapse of long fifteen years although it was repeatedly assured of being implemented quite sometimes back and many a time in the recent past. Needless to say that such an inordinate dilly-dallying has given rise to a considerable degree of simmering discontent in the minds of the entire Ministerial Cadres on one hand while all COBs & Branches of M.S.A on the other.

This CEC Meeting takes a satisfactory as well as conducive note of the fact that in the very recent official meeting between the Surveyor General of India & the COBs of M.S.A held at Dehradun on 10th instant of September 2018 the respected Surveyor General, based on his very recent talks over the subject issue in the DS&T, firmly assured the Staff Side of getting the long-awaited CADRE RESTRUCTURING implemented shortly (say, maximum by 2018-end). It was officially intimated to us that the Finally Consolidated, Modified & Amended Cadre Restructuring Proposals had been submitted by S.G. to DS&T vide No. W-2527/709-Cadre Restructuring dated 4th July, 2018. Earlier also, Final Proposals were submitted from S.G. to D.S.&T on 13th March, 2018 and we the Staff Side of M.S.A. S.O.I exclusively want our Cadre Restructuring based on 13th March 2018 Recommendations from back date right at DST-level itself to be got implemented by November-end 2018 keeping in view that our members throughout the Country do hardly want to wait any further for getting such a Government Exercise like C.R. implemented.

This important meeting, therefore, urges upon the Hon'ble Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry & Department of Science & Technology kindly to complete all pending processes, if any at the earliest and implement the unnecessarily delayed Cadre Restructuring right by November-end 2018 at DST-level itself in favour of the staff members.
