The govt. has issued the Notification of implementation of the recommendations of Seventh Pay Commission on 25th July, 2016, this was the last week of the month of July 2016 and the ministerial staff were busy to finalise the drawal of salary for the said month. It is important to mention here that even at this stage, the salary of all the employees were disbursed in accordance to the provisions of 7th CPC's recommendations which is appreciable. They also completed the arrear bills of every employee accordingly in time. These all work were in addition to their regular routine work allotted to them.

It is also pertinent to mention here that the fox to PFMS as well as the entries of the recoveries too. As such, the Ministerial staff has done their jobs with full dedication and devotion to meet out the requirement of the present scenario. This is a matter of satisfaction.

The aforesaid facts are sufficient enough to explain the hard ministerial staff also assigned with the new types of work i.e. revised the pension of the pensioners, the method of preparation of pay bills now have been changed from work of the ministerial cadre.
