**RESOLUTION NO. 1**

**Resolution adopted at the 14th All India Conference of Ministerial Staff Association,  
Survey of India held at Jaipur on 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> November, 2017**

This All India Conference expresses its deep anguish and concern as a result of the series of abortive actions as have so far been taken by the Departmental and Governmental Authorities on the question of implementation of Cadre Restructuring in Survey of India in respect of Ministerial Staff since last more than 13 years.


The AIC and the entire Delegates attending the same from different parts of the Country expresses its utter displeasure coupled with a degree of frustration over such inordinate and irresponsible delay in favourably settling this sensitive/burning issue despite lapse of more than 13 years which stands deplorable. This Conference, therefore, unanimously resolves that the issue of Cadre Restructuring be implemented maximum by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2017 for which the Authorities at Dehra Dun and Delhi must leave no stone unturned for implementing the same by that period as, otherwise, it will be difficult to contain the simmering discontent amongst the members thereafter meaning that the disappointed Ministerial Cadres as a whole will break into appropriate agitational means causing dislocation to the smooth functioning in offices.




