Dear Comrades,


Hope this letter of ours finds you all in the best of health & spirit. Also hope that by this time the information about holding of our 14th A.I.C. at JAIPUR on 8th & 9th November, 2017 has duly reached all of you. Needless to say that we want 100% participation of branches in the A.I.C. as many important decisions/programmes will have to be adopted/taken in the same. Meanwhile, as a preparatory to the ensuing A.I.C. as also on invitation to visit Jaipur from the host branch, we accompanied by one each comrade from Kolkata & Dehra Dun visited Jaipur on 3rd/4th Sept, 2017, met all members, saw a number of suitable places in & outside the office, met Adl. SG & Director and had useful talks with them and ultimately decided that the Open & Delegates' Sessions of the A.I.C. would be convened at the most suitable place in the compound of Rajasthan GDC itself. In the evening an emergent general body meeting was held at the Recreation Hall in our presence which was attended by 100% members.


2. On 4th Midnight our 4-Member Team had left Jaipur for New Delhi where we arrived in the next morning i.e. 5th Sept. The main purpose of our visit to Delhi was a two-fold one. The first fold was to duly rejuvenate MSA, Delhi Branch activities to the extent as necessary (keeping in view that our Delhi Branch was almost defunct since last few years), collect subscription & payment of CHQ Quota and attend the important AIC as Branch Representatives. Amidst our busiest schedules, we had to attend & address two g.b. meetings (one at Delhi GDC's Office on 5th a.n. while the other at Western Printing Group Office on 6th a.n.) and both the meetings were attended to by 100% ministerial staff of respective offices. They were very much convinced and, to speak the truth, MSA, Delhi Branch got practically re-organized in our presence. It was agreed to pay CHQ Quota from 2015 onwards at the earliest as also the Branch would participate in the Jaipur AIC.

The second-fold purpose was to visit DST's office, meet & have dialogues with available senior officials, submit copies of some important letters/papers to them for ready reference and pressurize them for earliest implementation of long-awaited. C.R. right at DST-level itself. And we could do everything there at DST on 5th Sept, 2017 in our meeting with the Respected Joint Secretary (Adm.) Shri B.S. Rawat. Replies/responses to a good number of DST's letters/reminders were not received from SGO. We could, however, get copies of some of DST's letters/reminders for our onward necessary action with the present SG Himself within his regime ending in this very month itself considering the matter as 'war-footing emergency'. The Joint Secretary (Adm.) had with him some other senior & responsible official (Mr. Sinha) in the discussion with us.

4. In fine it can be said that our risky as well as courageous drive or mission at Jaipur & New Delhi was considerably successful one in all respects. Keep morale high. Please give this letter an immediate & wide circulation to members, Greetings.
